






9:30 Visit the Halles of Narbonne, the Cathedral of San Justo and City Hall.

Narbonne was founded in 118 BC. It was the first colony Roman outside Italy. Among the most spectacular buildings in Narbonne is the Archbishop's Palace, built between the thirteenth and fourteenth centuries monuments.

12:00 Lunch in the Chapter House (goat terrine, ham and mesclun, lamb Cathar country, with almond cake toasted pine nuts)

The origins of the town date back to prehistoric times, but in the Middle Ages, with the Cathars became the foundation of heresy in the eyes of the Pope. An important event in the history of the town when it was given to Simon de Montfort. His son became King of France.


